## Year 11 update - Easter revision, internal assessments and teacher-assessed grades

In January, we wrote to you explaining that students would be given teacher-assessed grades for their GCSE results. One outcome of the government's consultation is that exam boards will provide **mini-assessments**, which schools can use to provide part of their portfolio of evidence. They are to be taken during class time and marked by teachers using mark schemes provided by the boards.

Most schools have decided to use these mini-assessments, and as part of the Spelthorne schools' group and the BET we will do likewise. The timeline around internal assessments is as follows:

The key message delivered to students, and we would like you to reiterate it, is that these mini assessments are not another set of mocks, nor are they GCSE exams. They are simply a test completed during their lesson time, which can be used as further evidence alongside their classwork, homework, remote learning, mocks and any coursework where applicable, to award the students the grade that they truly deserve. Students who qualify for access arrangements in tests will have these provided.

Easter revision sessions will start on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> April, delivered via Microsoft Teams. Each subject has a 90-minute session that will be focused on preparing the students for the internal assessments. We urge students to use the second week of the Easter holidays to relax. We have a busy half term ahead of us.

Candidates are entered under the name format of first name + middle name + (legal) surname and this is how it will show on certificates. The deadline for return is **Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> March**.

You will also be wondering about the final leaving date for students. Again, we are working very closely with local schools to provide parity and will be in touch as soon as we have further details.
